### Adapted strollers...Henry

Henry is not able to walk more than a few feet on his own right now, and due to his blindness and his physical delays, it will be a very long road to independent walking. So we really needed a safe way for Henry to ride the school bus to pre-school as well as to provide mobility in general as he is getting to big for the "baby" strollers now.

Our insurance told us that the chair would be covered, so we thought we could just place the order and get it in a timely manner. So we had him fitted for his chair back in January of this year. However, once we realized how high the out of pocket cost would be, we had to hold off on the order and decide what to do. We could not afford the cost, so we settled on borrowing a used chair from the school. It was ok for the bus trips, but

it wasn't really what he needed. And we couldn't use it for outings because the wheels were not in good enough condition and would shake after pushing it a few feet.

Then we heard about Thumbuddy Special, and we were so relieved that the cost of the chair was not going to inhibit Henry from getting the equipment he needed any longer! We received his brand new, beautiful chair just in time for Henry to use it to start back to pre-school at the end of August! He looks so comfortable in it, and I feel so much more confident sending him to school on the bus in his new sturdy chair! The wheels are great for long walks, too. It also has plenty of room for growth, so we will be using it for years to come!



Thank you so much for providing Henry with a safe, appropriate chair that fits all of his needs! We are so relieved that he finally has his own chair after using the borrowed chair for so long. This is thankfully one less thing for us to worry about, and now we can focus on Henry's schooling, his

therapies, and just having fun

going out as a family!
